## ALCOHOL

For CC and Royal London Cup matches only, spectators are permitted to bring either four cans of lager, beer or cider, or one bottle of wine (up to 75cl) into the ground.

Under guidance from the England and Wales Cricket board, no alcohol can be brought into the ground for Vitality Blast (T20) matches. Under no circumstances must glass containers be brought into the ground at any match.

### SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted in any seated area. If you wish to smoke, please leave the stand and move to one of the concourse areas.

### LOST TICKETS

Lost or misplaced tickets can be replaced at the discretion of Durham Cricket.

### REFUND POLICY

#### County Championship (CC)

No refunds will be given. In the event of less than 20 overs being played in a day, ticket holders will be entitled to a complimentary ticket for any alternative CC or Royal London Cup match scheduled to be played in 2021. Tickets must be claimed from the Box Office before the day of the chosen match and are subject to availability.

#### Royal London Cup (50L)

No refunds will be given. In the event of a no result and less than 10 overs being played in a day, ticket holders will be entitled to a complimentary ticket for any alternative CC or Royal London Cup match scheduled to be played in 2021. (This excludes: Quater–Finals, Semi–Finals & Final.) Tickets must be claimed from the box office before the day of the chosen match and are subject to availability.

#### Vitality Blast (T20)

In the event of a no result and less than 9.5 overs being played, ticket holders should send their match tickets to the Box Office for a refund (minus the £1.50 admin fee) or exchange their ticket for another T20 fixture, excluding Quater-Finals and Finals-Day. Refund policy will expire 28 days after the last home group stage fixture. Season ticket holders will not be refunded the face value of the match ticket. The Club will take into consideration any such restricted play or match cancellation at the end of the season and determine wether a refund is applicable.

In the event the game does not take place the tickets will be valid for any of the remaining fixtures by presenting your match ticket at the gate. (Tickets not valid for knockout rounds). If you would prefer a refund this can be requested from the box office by handing in or sending in your match tickets

Season ticket holder refunds are at the club discretion and will only be reviewed if more than one game does not take place.

## RULES RELATING TO CROWD BEHAVIOUR

- 1. The club reserves the right to:
- Close bars at any time to restrict the consumption of alcohol
- Eject from the ground any persons under the influence of alcohol and/or illegal substances
- Smoking will not be allowed in any internal area (including hospitality balconies) or stands during matches. Further details are given in the Club's Smoking Policy which is available from reception.

- 3. Unauthorised persons are prohibited from entering the playing area at all times. Players and officials regard entry onto the playing area as a threat to their safety. Unauthorised persons entering the field of play will be ejected from the ground and charged under the Public Order Act. During intervals in play entry to the field will be at the discretion of the Club. During these times people playing on the field should not use a hard ball.
- 4. The climbing of, or standing upon, barriers, walls, or perimeter fencing in and around the ground is strictly forbidden.
- 5. The throwing of any article inside the ground is strictly forbidden.
- Anyone using threatening behaviour, racist chants or insulting words which may cause a Breach of Peace will be ejected from the ground.
- 7. The obstruction of gangways, access ways, exits, entrances or stairways, congregating in non-designated areas or seeking entry to stands or seats for which the spectator does not hold a valid ticket is strictly forbidden.
- 8. Anyone refusing to obey the instruction or direction of an Official of the Club, Club Steward or Police Officer on any matter relating to crowd control or general behaviour will be ejected from the ground.
- 9. Only persons specifically authorised by the Club are perrmitted to offer newspapers, periodicals or other articles at the ground.
- 10. Only those lotteries promoted and conducted on behalf of Durham Cricket are permitted inside the ground.
- 11. Any person who is convicted of a criminal offence resulting from misbehaviour which was committed during the course of a match either involving or hosted by Durham Cricket, may be banned from all matches played at Emirates Riverside.
- 12. It is not permissible to add to the height of a seat on the ground by using any method which obstructs the view of those seated behind (this includes the practice of stacking chairs)
- 13. It is prohibited for any photograph, video recording, film sketch, painting or other image, score service or commentary to be used for any commercial purpose without prior written authorisation from the Cheif Executive of the club.
- 14. All persons enetering Durham Cricket matches are admitted subject to ground regulations and the rules and regulations of the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB)
- 15. Durham Cricket reserves the right to amend these ground regulations from

### RULES RELATING TO GROUND ADMISSION

- 1. As the ground authority, Durham Cricket reserves the right to refuse admission to any person for whatever reason.
- 2. All matches are played in accordance with the rules and regulations of the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB)
- 3. All persons entering the ground must pay admission, hold valid membership card or have a valid match ticket. Memberships were an age concession is claimed may require proof of identity and age.

- 4. NO alcohol will be allowed to be brought into the ground when full international matches, Vitality Blast matches, domestic Quater-Finals, Semi-Finals, Finals or any other ECB designated matches are being played.
- 5. During other domestic games, a limited amount of alcohol will be permitted to be brought into the ground. This is at the discretion of the club and is limited per person to:
- No more than four cans of beer, lager or cider.
- No more than 75cl of wine, in a plastic container.
- No glass containers allowed in the ground.
- The club reserves the right to refuse admission to any person under the influence of alochol and/or illegal substances.
- 7. Refund of cash admission charges will be at the discretion of the club except where certain competitions have specified refund schemes. Further details for each competition are available from the Box Office.
- 8. The following items are not permitted to be brought into the ground:
  Glass bottles and glasses | Knives and other offensive weaopns | Fireworks
  Gas and smoke canisters | Flares | Klaxons and megaphones
  Banners which could severely restrict the view or be offensive to the other
  spectators | Musical bands or instruments other than those with prior agreement
  in writing from the ground authority | Any dangerous articles or substances not referred to above.
- Entry to the ground is only permitted to spectators who agree to be searched on entry if requested by a Club Steward or person designated by the Club.
- 10. The Club accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to property or injury to persons while on club premisses.
- 11. Dogs are permitted within the ground but owners must have a valid dog pass. These are available from our Box Office for £10 and are valid for the full 2021 season
- 12. Group discounts are available for Royal London One Day Cup and Vitality Blast matches. These are only available 24 hours in advance of the match, for enquiries please contact the Box Office.
- 13. Durham Cricket reserves the right to amend these admission regulations from time to time and to refuse admission to any person or to eject any person whose conduct they deem to be disorderly or otherwise unacceptable at their sole and absolute disrection.

## BY BUS

Chester-le-Street can be accessed by a number of bus routes, including:

- Go North East 78 Sunderland, Shiney Row, Great Lumley,
   Chester-le-Street. Bus stop outside thr ground. Every 30 minutes.
- Go North East 21 'Angel' operates between Newcastle, Gateshead, Low Fell, Birtley, Chester-le-Street, Pity Me, Framwellgate Moor, Durham. It operates every 15 minutes Monday to Saturday and every 30 minutes on Sundays.
- Go North East X21 'Pronto' service operates between Bishop Auckland,
   Durham, Chester-le-Street, and is then non-stop to Gateshead and Newcastle.
   It operates twice an hour Monday to Saturday daytime and every 60 minutes on a Saturday.

## BY RAIL
