### **Pitch**

The match will be played on pitch 12.

### **Is car parking available?**

No, car parking has now sold out and will not be available to purchase online or on the day. If you don't have a parking pass please do not travel to the car park on Wednesday.

### **Where is the drop off/pick up points?**

All drop offs and pick-ups from the event including taxis, minibuses, will be from the hardstanding parking in the Park. Access from there to the ground will be then using the underpass.

### **Are tickets available to purchase on the day/night?**

Limited single seating will be available to purchase on the night but with limited seats available around the ground we don't recommend waiting to buy tickets on the night.

### **I have tickets to collect, where can I do this?**

The ticket collection point will be at Gate 2 and will be open from gates opening time. All other ticketing enquiries will also be dealt with from Gate 2.

Gate 1 – Hospitality and Media

Gate 2 – General admission (plus all ticket collects and enquiries)

Gate 3 – General admission

Gate 4 – General admission & Bannatynes

Gate 5 – General admission

Gate 6 – Media



**Are there catering units on site?**

Yes, there are several catering units on site offering a range of food options. These will be positioned in various points around the gap. Please view map for more information.

**Venue & Facilities**

During this fixture the Durham Cricket Sensory Room and Multi Faith rooms will be available. Durham Cricket are attempting to ensure the Seat Unique Riverside is fully inclusive to all our visitors. During this fixture, to enhance customer experience, we will have a Sensory Room, Changing Places facility and a Multi Faith room available.

Based in the media centre, Durham Cricket's Sensory Room is available for the first time at an international cricket fixture. The room is designed to make cricket accessible to all people with neuro-diverse needs who might otherwise feel uncomfortable attending the game. It provides a safe, relaxing space for individuals and families to enjoy an unrivalled view of the game. There will be sign posts on the day to access both rooms.

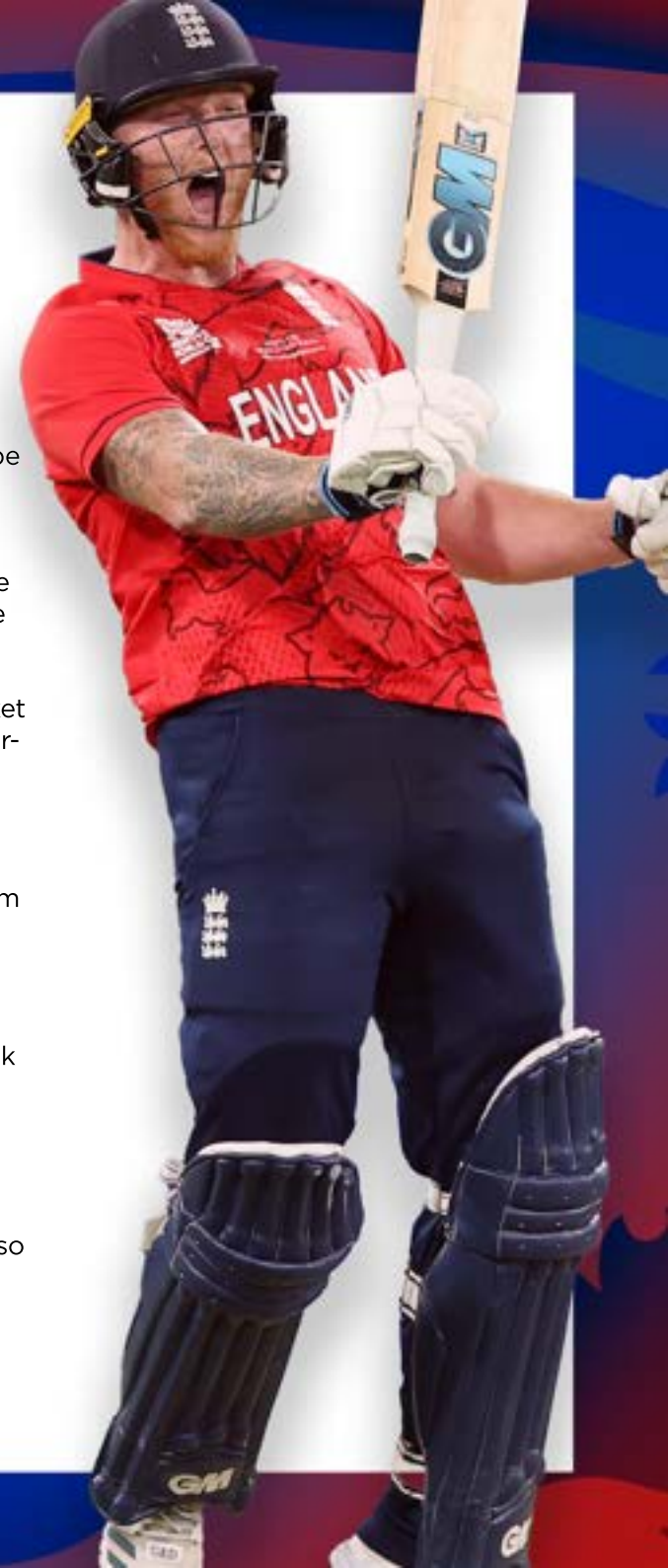
For all facilities located around the ground such as Sensory Room, Changing Places, Multi-faith area, food & drink and toilets, please view the ground map attached to the email.
